

Christie Lake Camp – Directions from the 401

- Take Hwy 10 (Division St. in Kingston) north from Kingston and the 401
- When Hwy 10 ends in Westport, turn left (onto Hwy 42 west)
- Turn left a minute or two later when Hwy 42 ends.
- Make the next right, onto Hwy 36. The Beer Store is on your left as you make this turn.
- About 10-15 minutes down this road, you come to a 4-way intersection. You make a right onto County Rd. 6. This road is also called Althorpe Rd., and there is a sign that indicates that this road goes to the south shore of Christie Lake. The sign also mentions Farren Lake and Crosbie Lake. If you hit Bolingbrooke or Hwy 7 you've gone too far.
- Christie Lake Camp is about 10 minutes down County Rd. 6, on your left. It's just at the top of a small hill. The camp is marked by a sign that says "Christie Lake Camp", some big gates, and there's a house inside the entrance. Just before the camp is the intersection with Hanna Rd., so look carefully at that point. If you come to Dewitt Corners, Glen Tay or Perth you've gone too far.
- Follow the camp road down the hill until the parking lot.
